Present Perfect Continuous

SUBJECT	FORM
I / You / We	have been [verb]-ing
He / She / It	has been [verb]-ing
They	have been [verb]-ing

Usage: Actions started in the past continuing to the present moment with emphasis on duration.

Future Perfect Simple

SUBJECT	FORM
I / You / We	will have [past part.]
He / She / It	will have [past part.]
They	will have [past part.]

Usage: Actions that will be completed before a specific point in the future.

Conditional Perfect

SUBJECT	FORM
I / You / We	would have [past part.]
He / She / It	would have [past part.]
They	would have [past part.]

Usage: Hypothetical past situations that did not actually occur.

Past Perfect Continuous

SUBJECT**FORM**

All Subjects

had been [verb]-ing

Usage: Actions that were ongoing up until another specific point in the past.

The Passive Voice (Complex Tenses)

TENSE**PASSIVE STRUCTURE****EXAMPLE**

Past Perfect

had been + [past part.]The report *had been finished*.Future
Perfect**will have been + [past
part.]**The project *will have been
completed*.
