

VERB CONJUGATION REFERENCE CHART

Standard English Grammar Template: 001-A

ASPECT	PAST TENSE	PRESENT TENSE	FUTURE TENSE
Simple	I/You/He/They worked <i>"I worked yesterday."</i>	I/You/They work He/She/It works <i>"I work every day."</i>	All will work <i>"I will work tomorrow."</i>
Continuous	I/He was working You/They were working <i>"I was working at 5pm."</i>	I am working He/She is working <i>"I am working now."</i>	All will be working <i>"I will be working then."</i>
Perfect	All had worked <i>"I had worked before lunch."</i>	I/You/They have worked He/She has worked <i>"I have worked here for years."</i>	All will have worked <i>"I will have worked 8 hours."</i>
Perfect Continuous	All had been working <i>"I had been working all day."</i>	I/You/They have been working He/She has been working <i>"I have been working lately."</i>	All will have been working <i>"I will have been working."</i>

Notes: Irregular verbs follow unique patterns in the Simple Past and Past Participle forms. Always check the base form for irregular changes (e.g., go/went/gone).
