RAINFOREST NAME	PRIMARY REGION	KEY COUNTRIES & CHARACTERISTICS
Amazon	South America	Brazil, Peru, Colombia. Largest tropical rainforest on Earth; spans the Amazon Basin.
Congo Basin	Africa	DRC, Congo, Gabon. Second largest; characterized by dense swamp forests and high biodiversity.
Valdivian	South America	Chile, Argentina. Rare temperate rainforest known for ancient angiosperm trees.
Daintree	Oceania	Australia (Queensland). World's oldest continuously surviving tropical rainforest.
Southeast Asian	Asia	Indonesia, Malaysia, Thailand. Includes the ancient lowland forests of Borneo and Sumatra.
Tongass	North America	United States (Alaska). Largest temperate rainforest in the US; high old-growth density.
