Population density is a measurement of population per unit area. It is typically expressed as individuals per square kilometer (km<sup>2</sup>).

Monaco	19,000+	Ultra-High	Coastal European enclave
Singapore	8,000+	High	Major island trade hub

India	480+	Medium-High	High agricultural river basins
United Kingdom	275+	Medium	Industrialized urban centers
United States	35	Low	Large land mass, vast wilderness
Australia	3	Ultra-Low	Interior largely uninhabitable

## Key Concepts

- **Arable Land:** Density is often higher near fertile soil and fresh water.
- **Urbanization:** Shift from rural to city living increases localized density.
- **Physical Constraints:** Deserts, mountains, and tundras naturally lower density.
