MEDICATION & DOSAGE	COMMON SIDE EFFECTS	SEVERE WARNINGS (CONTACT DOCTOR)	INTERACTIONS/NOTES
Lisinopril 10mg - Once Daily	Dizziness, dry cough, headache, fatigue.	Swelling of face/lips, fainting, yellowing of eyes/skin, high potassium signs.	Avoid salt substitutes containing potassium.
Metformin 500mg - Twice Daily	Nausea, diarrhea, stomach upset, metallic taste.	Lactic acidosis (extreme tiredness, weakness, muscle pain, cold feeling).	Take with meals to reduce stomach upset.
Atorvastatin 20mg - Evening	Joint pain, cold-like symptoms, sore throat.	Unexplained muscle pain/weakness, dark urine, liver tenderness.	Avoid large amounts of grapefruit juice.

MEDICATION & DOSAGE	COMMON SIDE EFFECTS	SEVERE WARNINGS (CONTACT DOCTOR)	INTERACTIONS/NOTES
Amoxicillin 500mg - 3x Daily	Nausea, mild rash, vomiting.	Severe watery/bloody diarrhea, seizures, unusual bruising.	Finish the entire course even if feeling better.

RED FLAG SYMPTOMS (Seek Emergency Care Immediately)

- Difficulty breathing or shortness of breath
- Swelling of the tongue, throat, or face (Angioedema)
- Chest pain or rapid/irregular heartbeat
- Sudden vision changes or severe confusion
- Severe allergic reaction (Anaphylaxis)
