MEDICATION & DOSAGE	COMMON SIDE EFFECTS	RARE / SERIOUS SYMPTOMS	PHARMACIST NOTES
Lisinopril <i>10mg Oral Tablet</i>	Dizziness, headache, dry persistent cough.	Seek Care: Swelling of face/lips, yellowing of skin, fainting.	Avoid potassium-rich salt substitutes unless advised.
Atorvastatin <i>20mg Oral Tablet</i>	Joint pain, cold-like symptoms, mild digestive upset.	Seek Care: Unexplained muscle pain, dark colored urine, extreme fatigue.	Take in the evening. Avoid grapefruit juice.
Metformin ER <i>500mg Extended Release</i>	Nausea, diarrhea, metallic taste in mouth.	Seek Care: Unusual muscle pain, difficulty breathing, rapid heartbeat.	Take with the evening meal to reduce stomach upset.
Amoxicillin <i>500mg Capsule</i>	Nausea, mild rash, stomach pain.	Seek Care: Severe diarrhea, hives, swelling of throat.	Complete the entire course even if feeling better.
