MEDICATION / DOSAGE	COMMON SIDE EFFECTS	SERIOUS (REPORT TO MD)	INTERACTION NOTES
Amoxicillin 500mg Oral	Nausea, diarrhea, mild rash, headache.	Severe abdominal pain, persistent vomiting, swelling of face/lips.	Avoid with methotrexate. Can affect birth control efficacy.
Lisinopril 10mg Oral	Dry cough, dizziness, fatigue, lightheadedness.	Fainting, high potassium symptoms, yellowing eyes/skin.	Monitor salt substitutes containing potassium.
Atorvastatin 20mg Oral	Joint pain, common cold symptoms, sore throat.	Unexplained muscle pain/weakness, dark urine, liver issues.	Avoid large quantities of grapefruit juice.
Metformin 850mg Oral	Bloating, gas, stomach upset, metallic taste.	Lactic acidosis symptoms (unusual sleepiness, rapid breathing).	Take with meals to minimize GI distress.
