

# Baby Teething Timeline

A General Guide to Tooth Eruption

<b>TOOTH TYPE</b>	<b>UPPER TEETH (MAXILLA)</b>	<b>LOWER TEETH (MANDIBLE)</b>
<b>Central Incisors</b>	8 – 12 Months	6 – 10 Months
<b>Lateral Incisors</b>	9 – 13 Months	10 – 16 Months
<b>Canines (Cuspids)</b>	16 – 22 Months	17 – 23 Months
<b>First Molars</b>	13 – 19 Months	14 – 18 Months
<b>Second Molars</b>	25 – 33 Months	23 – 31 Months

## Quick Symptoms Checklist

- â–j Increased Drooling
- â–j Irritability or Fussiness
- â–j Swollen/Tender Gums
- â–j Chewing on Hard Objects
- â–j Slight Rise in Temperature (under 101F)
