SYSTEM / SIDE EFFECT	MANAGEMENT STRATEGY	MEDICATIONS / INTERVENTION	ALERT THRESHOLD
Hematologic Neutropenia / Anemia	Monitor for fever; avoid crowds; rest frequently.	Filgrastim (G-CSF) injections as directed.	Fever > 100.4F
Gastrointestinal Nausea / Vomiting	Small, frequent meals; hydration; ginger products.	Ondansetron 8mg every 8 hours as needed.	Unable to keep fluids down
Dermatologic Rash / Hand-Foot	Fragrance-free urea cream; avoid hot water.	Topical Hydrocortisone 1% or Bag Balm.	Blistering or peeling
Neurological Neuropathy	Fall prevention; loose-fitting footwear.	B-Complex vitamins; Gabapentin (if prescribed).	Difficulty walking
Mucositis Mouth Sores	Salt/Soda rinses; soft toothbrush.	Magic Mouthwash (Lidocaine/Maalox mix).	Unable to swallow
