- Vertebral Artery *a. vertebralis*

- Aortic Arch *arcus aortae*
- Celiac Trunk *truncus coeliacus*
- Renal Arteries *aa. renales*
- Superior Mesenteric *a. mesenterica sup.*

- Subclavian *a. subclavia*
- Brachial *a. brachialis*
- Radial / Ulnar *a. radialis/ulnaris*
