

LYMPHATIC SYSTEM ANATOMY

Major Lymph Node Clusters & Drainage Pathways

[ANATOMICAL ILLUSTRATION AREA]

- **Cervical Nodes** Located in the neck; drains the head and neck regions.
- **Axillary Nodes** Located in the underarm; drains the breast, arm, and upper chest.
- **Supratrochlear Nodes** Located near the elbow; drains the lower arm and hand.
- **Mesenteric Nodes** Located in the abdominal cavity; drains the intestines.
- **Inguinal Nodes** Located in the groin; drains the lower limbs and external genitalia.
- **Popliteal Nodes** Located behind the knee; drains the lower leg and foot.
