

THE MALE REPRODUCTIVE SYSTEM

External Structures

- **PENIS** The primary organ for sexual intercourse and urination.
- **SCROTUM** The pouch of skin containing the testicles, regulating temperature.
- **TESTICLES (TESTES)** Glands responsible for producing sperm and testosterone.
- **EPIDIDYMIS** A coiled tube where sperm cells mature and are stored.

Internal Structures

- **VAS DEFERENS** The duct that conveys sperm from the testicle to the urethra.
- **PROSTATE GLAND** Secretes fluid that nourishes and protects sperm.
- **SEMINAL VESICLES** Glands that produce the majority of the fluid in semen.
- **URETHRA** The tube that carries urine and semen out of the body.
