# THE MALE REPRODUCTIVE SYSTEM

## Clinical Reference Chart & Functional Anatomy

- **Testes** Primary reproductive glands responsible for sperm and testosterone production.
- **Epididymis** Coiled tube system where sperm cells mature and are stored.
- **Vas Deferens** Duct that transports mature sperm to the urethra in preparation for ejaculation.
- **Prostate Gland** Secretes alkaline fluid that nourishes and protects sperm.
- **Seminal Vesicles** Glands that produce the majority of the fluid volume of semen.
- **Urethra** The channel that conveys both urine and semen out of the body.
- **Scrotum** External sac of skin containing the testes, regulating temperature.
