

HUMAN SPINE SEGMENTS

Anatomical Reference Chart

Cervical Spine

C1 - C7 (7 Vertebrae)

Supports the head and facilitates neck rotation. Includes the Atlas and Axis.

Thoracic Spine

T1 - T12 (12 Vertebrae)

Attachment point for the rib cage. Provides stability and protects vital organs.

Lumbar Spine

L1 - L5 (5 Vertebrae)

Strongest and largest vertebrae. Supports the majority of body weight.

Sacrum & Coccyx

S1 - S5 & Tailbone

Fused vertebrae connecting the spine to the hip bones (pelvis).
