Anatomical Landmarks

Sacral Base (S1)

Sacral Promontory

Ala (Wing)

Posterior Sacral Foramina

Coccyx (Co1-Co4)

CLINICAL NOTES:

The sacrum consists of 5 fused vertebrae (S1-S5) providing stability to the pelvis. The coccyx consists of 3-5 vestigial segments.
