- **10** Pubic Arch

## GYNAECOID CHARACTERISTICS

The female pelvis is typically wider and shallower than the male pelvis. The pelvic inlet is oval or round, and the pubic arch angle is generally greater than 90 degrees to facilitate childbirth.

## STRUCTURAL FUNCTION

Designed for weight distribution and organ support, the bony pelvis connects the axial skeleton to the lower limbs while protecting the reproductive and urinary systems.
