

# HUMAN PELVIS: STRUCTURAL ANATOMY

## **Ilium**

The superior and largest region of the hip bone. Forms the iliac crest and the upper portion of the acetabulum.

## **Ischium**

The posteroinferior part of the hip bone. Supports body weight while sitting via the ischial tuberosity.

## **Pubis**

The anterior and smallest region. Joins the opposite pubic bone at the pubic symphysis.
