- 01 Ilium
- 02 Ischium
- 03 Pubis
- 04 Sacrum
- 05 Coccyx
- 06 Pubic Symphysis

KEY LANDMARKS

- 07 Iliac Crest
- 08 Acetabulum
- 09 Obturator Foramen
- 10 Ischial Tuberosity
- 11 Sacroiliac Joint
- 12 Pelvic Brim (Inlet)

CLINICAL CHARACTERISTICS (MALE)

• Narrower, heart-shaped pelvic inlet.

• Acute subpubic angle (less than 90).

• Heavier, thicker bone structure for muscle attachment.

• Narrower greater sciatic notch.
