

# SACROILIAC (SI) JOINT ANATOMY

Posterior and Anterior Structural Overview

**Anterior Sacroiliac Ligament:** Connects the anterior surface of the lateral sacrum to the ilium.

**Posterior Sacroiliac Ligament:** Strong ligaments connecting the sacral tubercles to the iliac tuberosity.

**Interosseous Ligament:** The strongest of the SI ligaments, located deep between the two bones.

**Pubic Symphysis:** Secondary cartilaginous joint maintaining pelvic ring stability.
