

# PRIMARY TEETH ANATOMY STRUCTURE

Note: Primary dentition consists of 20 teeth (10 maxillary, 10 mandibular).

## ANATOMICAL COMPONENTS

Part	Description
<b>Enamel</b>	Hard outer layer (thinner in primary teeth)
<b>Dentin</b>	Main structure beneath enamel
<b>Pulp</b>	Nerves and blood vessels (larger in primary)
<b>Cementum</b>	Connective tissue covering the root

Tooth Type	Upper Eruption	Lower Eruption
Central Incisor	8-12 Months	6-10 Months
Lateral Incisor	9-13 Months	10-16 Months
Canine (Cuspid)	16-22 Months	17-23 Months
First Molar	13-19 Months	14-18 Months
Second Molar	25-33 Months	23-31 Months
