ANATOMICAL FEATURE

DESCRIPTION / FUNCTION

Right Lobe

The largest lobe, occupying the right hypochondrium.

Left Lobe

Smaller, flattened lobe situated in the epigastric region.

Falciform Ligament

Peritoneal fold separating the right and left lobes.

Ligamentum Teres

Remnant of the umbilical vein at the base of the falciform ligament.

Gallbladder

Visible inferior to the right lobe; stores concentrated bile.

Note: Posterior lobes (Caudate and Quadrate) are not visible from this anterior perspective.
