

ANATOMICAL CHART: HUMAN LIVER LOBES

Anterior and Posterior Reference View

[ILLUSTRATION: ANATOMICAL POSITION OF LIVER LOBES]

Right Lobe

The largest lobe, situated in the right hypochondrium. Separated from the left lobe by the falciform ligament.

Left Lobe

Smaller, flattened lobe located in the epigastric and left hypochondriac regions.

Caudate Lobe

Located on the posterosuperior surface of the right lobe, situated between the IVC and the ligamentum venosum.

Quadrate Lobe

Located on the inferior surface of the right lobe, bounded by the gallbladder and the ligamentum teres.
