

# ANATOMY OF THE HUMAN LIVER

Major Lobes and Anatomical Landmarks

*[ Anterior / Posterior View Illustration ]*

## ANTERIOR LOBES

- **Right Lobe:** The largest lobe, situated in the right hypochondrium.
- **Left Lobe:** Smaller, flattened lobe extending into the epigastrium.
- **Falciform Ligament:** Separates the right and left lobes.

## POSTERIOR/INFERIOR LOBES

- **Caudate Lobe:** Situated on the upper posterior surface.
- **Quadrate Lobe:** Situated on the lower posterior surface.
- **Ligamentum Venosum:** Fibrous remnant of the ductus venosus.
