

BRONCHIAL TREE ANATOMY CHART

[*Illustration: Trachea bifurcation into Bronchial Tree*]

Division Level	Anatomical Name	Key Characteristics
Primary	Main Bronchi (Right & Left)	Extends from trachea to the hilum of the lungs. Right is shorter, wider, and more vertical.
Secondary	Lobar Bronchi	One for each lung lobe (3 on the right, 2 on the left). Branches directly from primary.
Tertiary	Segmental Bronchi	Supply bronchopulmonary segments. Approximately 10 in the right lung and 8-10 in the left.
Subsequent	Bronchioles	Microscopic branches leading to terminal bronchioles and alveoli; lack cartilage rings.
