

# ASCENDING COLON ANATOMY

[ ILLUSTRATION AREA ]

**Ileocecal Junction** The entry point from the small intestine to the large intestine.

---

**Cecum** The pouch-like beginning of the large intestine.

---

**Haustra** Small pouches caused by sacculations, giving the colon its segmented look.

---

**Teniae Coli** Three separate longitudinal bands of smooth muscle.

---

**Right Colic (Hepatic) Flexure** The sharp bend between the ascending and transverse colon.

---

**Epiploic Appendages** Small pouches of peritoneum filled with fat.
