**Ascending Colon**

**Ileocecal Valve**

**Terminal Ileum**

**Ileocecal Valve** A sphincter muscle situated at the junction of the small intestine (ileum) and the large intestine.

**Cecum** The intraperitoneal pouch that forms the beginning of the large intestine.

**Ascending Colon** The part of the colon located between the cecum and the right colic flexure.

**Vermiform Appendix** A narrow, blind-ended tube connected to the cecum, containing lymphoid tissue.
