

PANCREAS ANATOMY & DIGESTIVE INTEGRATION

[Central Diagram: Pancreas, Duodenum, and Common Bile Duct] Gallbladder Tail of Pancreas Duodenum

Anatomical Parts

- **Head:** Nestled in the curve of the duodenum.
- **Body:** The main central section.
- **Tail:** Tapered end reaching toward the spleen.
- **Pancreatic Duct:** Joins the bile duct.

Key Functions

- **Exocrine:** Produces digestive enzymes (Lipase, Amylase).
- **Endocrine:** Secretes Insulin and Glucagon.
- **Neutralization:** Releases Bicarbonate to buffer acid.
