

ANATOMY OF THE ADRENAL GLAND

Endocrine System Reference & Identification

[Adrenal Gland Diagram]

Capsule: The protective outer layer of connective tissue.

Adrenal Cortex: The outer region producing steroid hormones.

Adrenal Medulla: The inner core producing catecholamines.

Zona Glomerulosa: Produces mineralocorticoids (Aldosterone).

Zona Fasciculata: Produces glucocorticoids (Cortisol).

Zona Reticularis: Produces androgens (DHEA).
