

SUPERFICIAL VEINS OF THE BRACHIUM

Anatomical Reference Chart

[Anterior View Diagram: Cephalic, Basilic, and Median Cubital Veins]

VEIN NAME	ANATOMICAL PATH	TERMINATION
Cephalic Vein	Ascends lateral side of the biceps brachii; travels in the deltopectoral groove.	Axillary Vein
Basilic Vein	Ascends medial side of the biceps; pierces deep fascia in mid-arm.	Joins Brachial Veins to form Axillary Vein
Median Cubital	Oblique connection in the cubital fossa.	Communication between Cephalic and Basilic
Dorsal Venous Network	Originates from the hand, feeding into the main superficial trunks.	Cephalic/Basilic Origins
