

# MALE PELVIC FLOOR ANATOMY

## **Levator Ani**

Comprised of Puborectalis, Pubococcygeus, and Iliococcygeus. Supports pelvic viscera.

## **Coccygeus**

Posterior component of the pelvic diaphragm; pulls coccyx forward.

## **Bulbospongiosus**

Contributes to erection, ejaculation, and feelings of pelvic stability.

## **Ischiocavernosus**

Maintains erection by compressing the crus penis.

## **External Anal Sphincter**

Voluntary control for defecation; vital for core pressure regulation.

## **Perineal Membrane**

Fibrous tissue providing the foundation for the urogenital structures.
