

# PELVIC FLOOR FASCIA & CONNECTIVE TISSUE

*[Anatomical Diagram: Superior View of the Pelvic Endopelvic Fascia]*

## Parietal Fascia

- **Obturator Fascia** Covers the medial aspect of the obturator internus muscle.
- **Tendinous Arch (ATFP)** Linear thickening providing attachment for the levator ani.
- **Presacral Fascia** Connective tissue layer covering the sacrum and nerves.

## Visceral (Endopelvic) Fascia

- **Parametrium** Connective tissue extending laterally from the uterus.
- **Paracolpium** Lateral attachments of the vagina to the pelvic wall.
- **Pubocervical Fascia** Supporting layer between the bladder and vagina.

## Ligamentous Supports

- **Uterosacral Ligaments** Posterior stability for the cervix.
- **Cardinal Ligaments** Primary lateral support at the base of the broad ligament.
- **Pubourethral Ligaments** Support for the mid-urethra and continence.
- **Rectovaginal Septum** Connective tissue plane (Denonvilliers' fascia).
