#### **DATE FORMATTING EXAMPLE**

**Standard Date:** July 14, 1789

**Roman Format:** XIV . VII . MDCCLXXXIX

Note: When a smaller number precedes a larger one, it is subtracted (e.g., IV = 4, IX = 9).
